The purpose of setting up a new Bible House at this time in our history is to ensure mission sustainability and continuity into the coming years. We are living in tough times economically and the situation is likely to continue in this manner and may even get worse before it gets better. As believers, we are hopeful and praying that the good LORD makes the situation better as soon as it can be.

During an 1854 lecture at the University of Lille, French Microbiologist and Chemist Louis Pasteur said, “In the fields of observation, chance favors on the prepared mind.”

In the spiritual realm, we see a future where funds flowing into Uganda will be limited and the little that will come in, will have many strings attached to it. This is the reason for setting up a new commercial Bible House building to resource BSU mission work in the coming years.

We cannot take this for granted, but to express our sincere appreciation for believing in the project, given the very challenging season the Church has just gone through, with limited incomes.

As always and as pledged earlier, we have kept our grip on the mission and vision of The Bible Society of Uganda without wavering. You will read about the Audio Bibles being used across age and gender at a national level, Bible stories for the children augmented with Open the Book (OtB) program as well as the Trauma healing sessions that were done with new audiences. You will also read and see a pictorial coverage of the BSU's 37th AGA and New Testaments with Psalms and Proverbs that came in with support from the American Bible Society. The People With Visual Disability continued to make Bible Society shine at various Church functions as they took readings using the Braille Bible.

The Handwritten Bible project continues to be a major avenue of raising funds towards the new Bible House building and you will see pictures of some people who engaged with us in the last quarter. Additionally, the approved **Contribution Categories** ranging from WOOD to PLATINUM for individuals and Institutions that will be recognized as key supporters with amounts ranging from Ugx. 1,000,000 to Ugx. 100,000,000 continue to gain momentum. You too need to appear on this legacy record as the good Lord enables you. We do hope that the allotted shares to all major Church denominations in **Redeemable Preference Shares** as well will soon be taken up.

In the last quarter we joined the Church in congratulating the newly consecrated and enthroned 6th Bishop of the Diocese of Kigezi, the Rt. Rev. Gaddie Akanjuna, and you will find some of the pictures of this function in this edition of the Light Newsletter.

Once again, through our Life Membership appeal and story in this newsletter, do consider becoming one if you are not yet registered. At the end of this year, we plan to publish the fully paid up Life Members' list as part of the key contributors to the new Bible House. The Bible Society of Uganda believes that God's Word is life for all and therefore ensures that everyone everywhere within Uganda affordably accesses the Word of God in languages and media that communicate effectively to them. Through Bible Society, thousands of Christians have been able to access Bibles in print, audio, braille and Bible apps in over 20 local languages in Uganda. Lukung people with disabilities group in Pece - Gulu City have been one of the beneficiaries of the audio Bibles from the Bible Society of Uganda. It is a

group composed of 11 members who are either visually impaired, deaf or physically disabled.

The Bible Society of Uganda visited this group and gave them 10 Audio Bibles on their phones via SD memory cards. This was an answered prayer as they always desired to grow more in their faith in God. To reaffirm their commitment to engage with their Audio Bible, the group made a Bible reading plan that they would use to run their Bible study on a weekly basis. Two months later, the testimonies from the group members about the Audio Bibles are worth listening to.



“Before using the Audio Bible, I used to be so worried and my mind was always filled with many hurtful thoughts. The Audio Bible became my counsellor and every time I am invaded with worried thoughts, I put on the Audio Bible and happiness fills my heart again.”

Bible Society has tremendously impacted my life

“I have always heard about the Bible Society of Uganda but had never experienced her impact this much.”

This was said by the Mother's Union President of West Ankole Diocese during the closing ceremony of the three-day Bible Based Trauma Healing equipping session at Western Meridian Hotel in Bushenyi.

Mother's Union leaders from the 5 districts of Greater Bushenyi which make West Ankole Diocese gathered for a Bible Based Trauma Healing equipping session that was organized by the Bible Society of Uganda (BSU).

The ladies, who lamented that the seminar had come at a wrong time of taking the children back to school, changed their mind and noted that there could never have been a better timing than this and ended up making phone calls to all who had not attended to ensure that they didn't miss out on the last two days. This made the number of participants to keep growing.

The sessions gave women opportunities to express their feelings and critically analyse the pain and hardships they had experience over the past years. This was clearly realized as they wrote their laments and pain and later taking them to the cross of Jesus Christ. Testimony after testimony, they shared deeply and it was great to hear how God had worked in their lives with many receiving healing, jobs for their beloved, payment of debts among others. It was amazing that one of the ladies who was following up her lost academic documents for the last twelve years got her break through during the session.

The Diocesan Secretary, who also experienced the impact of Bible Based Trauma Healing promised to organize more sessions for the men and clergy. Five Women signed up as Life Members of BSU and many others became annual members and took tins to make contributions towards the New Bible House construction project.

Is the Bible not enough?

During the past two years the Bible Society of Uganda distributed Talking Bibles to the slums of Kimumbasa (Bwaise) Mengo Kisenyi, Namuwongo, and Kireka” Acholi quarters”. The main beneficiaries for our intervention are the youth who find such a place convenient because of it’s low cost of living. In such a place the few who earn a decent income are the ones involved in small scale businesses dealing mainly in domestic groceries and bars, the rest engage in prostitution for girls and stealing for boys who in most cases are involved in drug abuse. In most cases the later shares their loot with the former for their services.

When the Talking Bibles arrived in these places some welcomed them with both hands since most of them were not allowed to move because of the COVID-19 restrictions and some started listening to the same, eventually gave their lives to Christ, committed themselves to walk a Christian

transformed lifestyle and abandoned their bad practices only to go back when survival hit hard.

One of the gang leaders in Kireka Acholi quarters said “My friends always pass by and ask me to go with them to work, (stealing) sometimes I refuse, nevertheless because I have nothing to eat, I am forced by the circumstances to go with them and do what I hate most, stealing from people”.

“Giving us Scriptures without means to survive only makes us live a life of guilt” said Walter, because after learning what the Bible says you feel compelled to do what it teaches but in most cases the circumstances force you back to your old habits due to lack of both skills and capital to start a new living.

“We thank you for the Word of God but please help us to live the calling by providing for us with the skills and means to start a new life. Giving us Scriptures only awakens our conscience but the circumstances force us to do otherwise”. said Walter

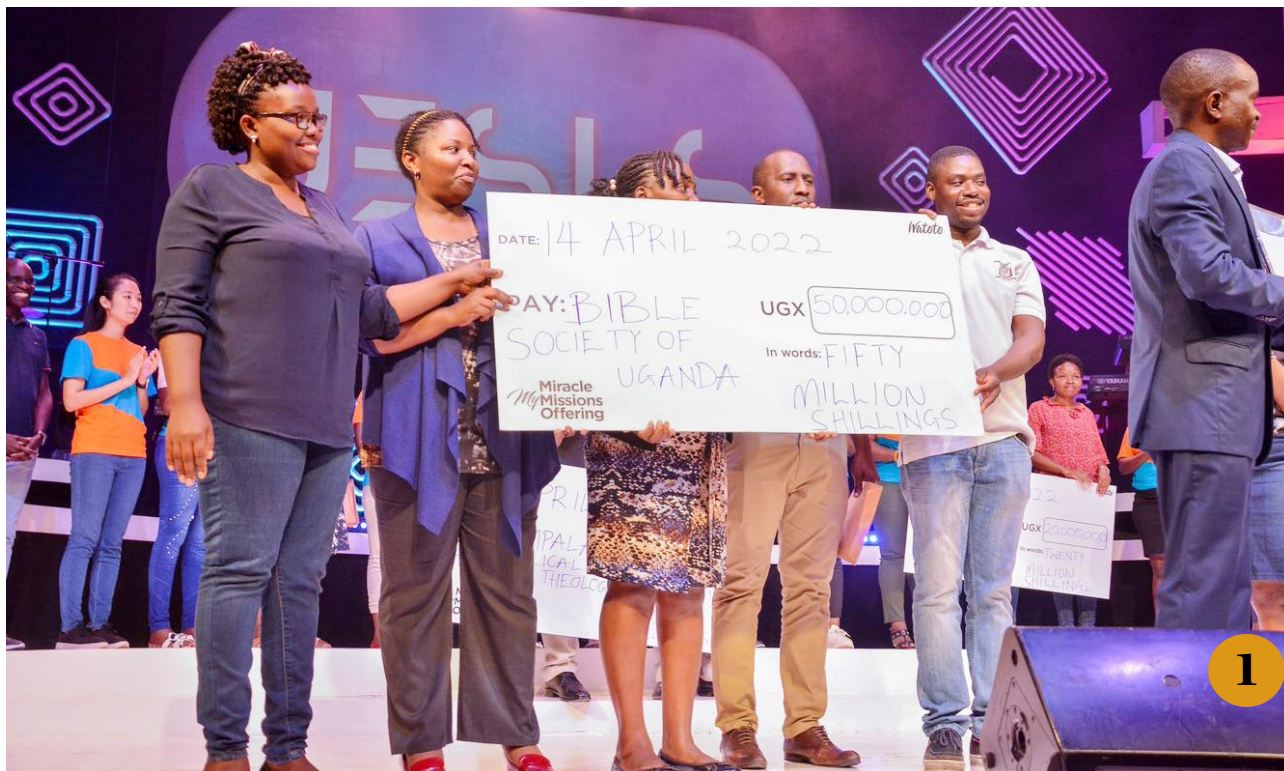

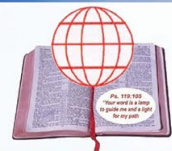

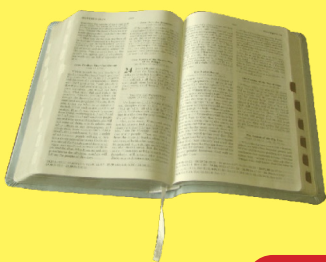
